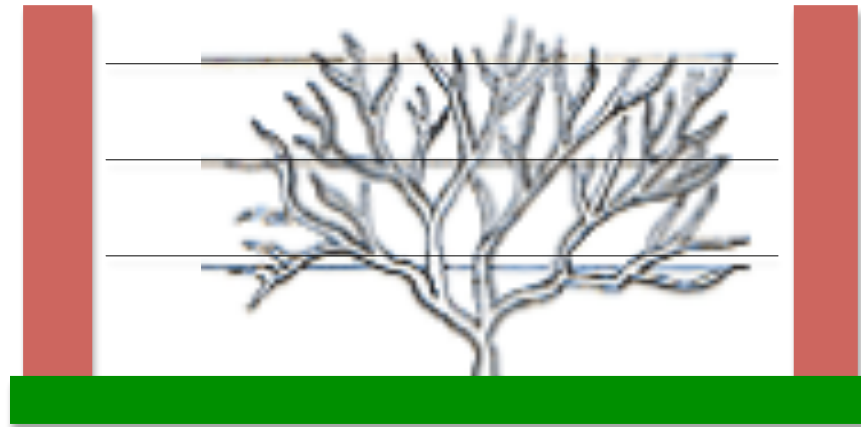


Fan trained fruit tree



Fan trained fruit trees can be grown on wire systems. Spacing of these trees is approximately 3.5 – 4m between plants. The picture shows a fan on a 3 wire system but more wires can be added. As a guide the distances between the wires should be 20in between the ground and the first wire and 18in between the remaining wires.

It is important that the graft union is above soil level.

Fans should be planted in the ground the same as with any other fruit tree.
